We encourage all SAPIA members to nominate at least one project, product, service or innovation, no matter how small or large.

The program is a platform for our members to showcase their work, and allows us to demonstrate that our members are promoting excellence in all aspects of sports, play and recreation design, construction, surfacing and installation. The entries are shared on SAPIA's social media pages, YouTube channel and website, gaining maximum exposure for members.

We love to see what you have been creating around the country, from the design phase through to completion.

This year's Industry Awards competition opens on **1 March 2023** and closes on **31 May 2023**.

Independent judges will then evaluate the entries. Winners will be announced and trophies presented at our annual National Conference, to be held in Sydney on 1 September 2023.

The Industry Awards categories (see next page) have been chosen to enable all our members, large and small, whether builders, surfacers, installers or other contractors, as well as manufacturers, suppliers or service providers, to enter their work for recognition.

EVALUATION

Depending on the category, evaluation criteria may include the following:

- layout/design
- site work/drainage
- base construction, surface adequacy and aesthetics
- floodlighting if applicable
- fencing if applicable, and
- overall impression of the finished project

Independent judges are appointed to the task of assessing the projects. Details identifying the entrants and project locations are removed to ensure entries are judged on their merits. Scores are awarded according to SAPIA's evaluation criteria, and the project scoring the highest number of points is adjudged the winner of that category. In categories with a large number of entries, 2nd and 3rd place getters may also be awarded.

RULES

Every financial member of the Sports & Play Industry Association is eligible and encouraged to enter.

Projects submitted may include those which have been completed within the three years preceding 31 May 2023, and which have not previously won a SAPIA Industry Award.

Members may enter as many projects as they wish. One Project Entry Form is required for each project entered. Attach or enclose plans/drawings if applicable, as well as photographs to assist the judging process. Before, during and after photos can be helpful, if available.

The entrant must be the owner of the photographs, information and drawings submitted with the entry, and by entering this Award competition authorises the Sports & Play Industry Association to release any of these materials, to reproduce them in publications, on the SAPIA website, in social media posts, news releases and other advertising materials, including those not pertaining to the Awards program, without compensation.

The judges' decision is final.

The administration fee for each entry is \$125.00. Once we have received your entry, an invoice will be raised.
